

City & Guilds Level 3 Assessor Qualifications

Our level 3 qualifications are perfect for anyone wanting to progress into a career as a Qualified Assessor. They provide a pathway for learners to gain an in-depth understanding of assessment and can lead to becoming a qualified Assessor

On these courses you will attend a three-day workshop to gain a detailed knowledge and understanding of assessment and then, if applicable, you will complete a portfolio showing competency-based evidence of assessing in your own workplace. To become a qualified Assessor, you will need to identify at least two learners for you to work with so you can develop skills and the evidence you need for the portfolio. You will need to be supported by an existing Assessor and an individual who is responsible for the Internal Quality Assurance in your organisation.

There are three Award level qualifications and one certificate. These are:

Level 3 Award in Understanding the Principles and Practices of Assessment-

This is the knowledge-only award for those who are interested in starting a career using assessment practice but are not currently practicing.

Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment-

This qualification is suited to practitioners who need to assess the demonstration of competence in a work environment using a variety of assessment methods. These will include observation, examination of work products, questioning, discussion, use of witnesses and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).

Level 3 Award in Assessing Vocationally Related Achievement-

This qualification is right for practitioners who assess knowledge and/or skills in vocationally related subject areas using a variety of methods. These could include assessments in a simulated environment, skills tests, oral and written questions, assignments, projects and case studies and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).

Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement-

This is the qualification made up from the 3 units above. This is relevant for those who are assessing both work-based competency and vocational achievement, using all the above listed methods.

Cost

The cost for this course is dependant on the number of units you need to complete.

The 3-day knowledge workshop costs £795.00 per person Excl VAT. The cost includes course notes, lunches and City and Guilds certification.



The other units, which require you to work individually with an Assessor, to build your portfolio of evidence, and be observed in the workplace cost £350.00 per unit Excl VAT.

Due to the requirement that you have at least one visit from an Assessor, we are only able to offer this part of the qualification to companies in Gloucestershire. Worcestershire, Herefordshire and Monmouthshire.

This makes the cost of the full Certificate level qualification £1,495.00 Excl VAT

Location

The course is run at our training centre a few minutes from junction 8 of the M5. We provide joining information with directions and start time and where appropriate a list of hotels.

The portfolio building requirements for the competency-based elements will require that your Assessor has access to you in your workplace.
